- (1) Remove loose screws (that cannot be tighten enough)
- (2) Put soft patty on the screw heads and the screw holes where screws are removed Dry the patty for 24 hours
- (3) Sand surfaces with #120, #240 and #400 #80 and #150 abrasive paper

Round edges with #60 abrasive paper


- (4) Wipe surfaces with wet cloth and dry them for one hour or more
- (5) Affix masking tape on the cut surfaces
- (6) Apply wood wax onto all the surfaces with sponge

Wood wax is to be applied after sliced veneer, cut surface tape and sitckers are affixed


